ART TRAINING (Agu's Downey:

Uzu's journey through ART (Advanced Rescue Training) is a testament to growth and the power of hands-on learning. As an instructor with a passion for skill development, Uzu embraced the physical and mental challenges of the course. Her experience highlights the importance of continuous training and the value of stepping outside one's comfort zone to become a more effective instructor.

What motivated you to pursue ART training, and how has it impacted your skills as an instructor?

I was motivated to do ART because I wanted to improve my skills in handling emergency situations. This training helped me respond better to difficult rescues and allows me to teach others the right way to stay safe while working at heights.

What were some of the most challenging aspects of the training, and how did you overcome them ? The hub rescue was challenging because it involved working in confined spaces, which made movement and access tricky. To overcome this, I focused on staying calm, using the right techniques to navigate tight areas, and working closely with my team also helped, as we supported each other to make the rescue more efficient.

Can you share a specific moment during the training that stood out for you?

What stood out for me during training was the importance of clear communication and teamwork. Staying connected with the team made a huge difference in how smoothly the rescue went

How does ART training prepare individuals to handle real-life rescue scenarios?

ART prepares individuals for real-life rescues by teaching decision-making, teamwork, and handling pressure. It provides hands-on practice with the proper techniques and equipment, helping people stay calm during emergencies.

Were there any teamwork aspects in the training that stood out to you? How did these benefit your overall experience?

Radios were a vital part of the teamwork during rescues, as they allowed for clear communication, quick updates, and better coordination. This helped ensure everyone was on the same page and allowed the team to react swiftly and effectively to situations.

How do you plan to incorporate what you learned in ART into your instructing or future career goals?

I plan to grow in my career by enhancing my skills in safety. Additionally, I want to train others in ART to pass on these crucial skills. SP
