ASSISTANT TO INSTRUCTOR Their Experience

At SP-Wind, our instructors play a crucial role in preparing the next generation of wind industry professionals. We sat down with Josh, Lihle, and Slugga to hear about their transition from assistant instructors to full instructors, and how their passion, experience, and growth are helping shape the future of training at SP-Wind.

A Path with Purpose

For Josh, becoming an instructor was driven by a love for teaching and a desire to help others grow. Lihle's journey started during a high school visit to a wind farm, which sparked a lasting interest in renewable energy. Slugga, with years of field and teaching experience behind him, saw instruction as a way to contribute in a more stable, long-term capacity.

Strength from Experience

As they continue to grow in their roles, Josh, Lihle, and Slugga are focused on making a lasting impact in the classroom and beyond.


